DAY ONE AND TWO: PONZA & PALMAROLA

Start your holiday with our warm welcome on board: we'll pop a bottle of the finest Champagne that you can sip while enjoying a breathtaking cruise to the remote islands of the Pontine Archipelago. Once in Ponza, nothing will be more romantic than wearing your masks and explore hand in hand the incredible underwater Roman ruins scattered along the coasts of Ponza and Palmarola. At sunset, the crew will arrange an amazing barefoot aperitivo on a secluded bay.

DAY THREE: VENTOTENE

The tiny island of Ventotene is less than two miles long. Captain Vaccaro will be glad to perform a very exciting circumnavigation of the island, stopping by the best spots to swim and admire the incredible marine life that populate those waters. Ashore, a visit to the ruins of Villa Iulia and a walk to the lighthouse are a must.

Dine on board, surrounded only by stars and candles.



DAY FOUR: ISCHIA

Ischia is also called the emerald island, thanks to its lush vegetation. After a long day exploring local bays, we'll book for you a tour of one of the many vineyards: walking around surrounded by the smell of ripe grapes while tasting the delicious local wine is a must in Ischia.

For dinner, the restaurant *pieds-dans-l'eau Indaco* will be perfect. An unforgettable experience is a night plunge in the bay of Sorgeto: natural pools of warm water under a roof of starry sky.





DAY FIVE: CAPRI

As soon as you get to Capri, you'll understand the reason of its fame: a very small island plunged in deep blue waters, small restaurants and huge Roman-style villas. The enchanting atmosphere of this place cannot be explained by words. Stop for a visit at the renowned Blue Grotto, a sea cave where the light reflects underwater and creates a blue reflection in the whole cavern and, after a Spritz in the Piazzetta and a dinner at Paolino under the lemon trees, dance the night away in the many clubs of the island

DAY SIX: POSITANO

Enjoy a cruise along the Amalfi Coast and stop at Conca Dei Marini to visit the suggestive "Emerald Grotto" and at Santa Croce beach to take a bath and admire the beautiful natural arch. In the afternoon, we'll arrange an unforgettable road trip: we'll book a spider and provide you with simple directions to make sure you enjoy all the best panoramas. Dine on the stunning terrace of the "Rada": after dinner the restaurant is liven-up by a live piano.



DAY SEVEN: SORRENTO

Sorrento offers a multitude of activities for travellers: the city center with its pathways that run along the main street, full of little workshops where you can buy local typical handicrafts, the natural marine reserve of Punta Campanella and the lively nightlife.

We suggest you to take an "aperitivo" on the suggestive Sky Bar of the Hotel Mediterraneo and head for dinner to the Michelin starred "Torre del Saracino".
